Tech Talk

From Bob Paterson, VP Tech

Hopefully everyone has successfully "unwinterized" their coaches, and run them long enough to get everything up to operating temperature, and THEN checked all fluid levels.

If you didn't change the oil and filter last fall, NOW is the time to do it. Remember to drain the oil when the engine is hot, to get all the suspended particles out with the old. Radiator fluids should also be changed every 3-4 years, to help reduce corrosion.

Don't forget the 'Check List' from last spring. Best way to use it is to have it 'laminated' at Staples, and use a grease pencil to check each item completed, then it can be rubbed off and saved until next spring.

Hopefully we will have a great turnout for the 'Rustbuster' in Morrisburg. There will be a very special **Silent Auction** consisting of a great number of items (both new and used) that have been donated to the club by Eric & Gertrude Knabe, for fundraising purposes.
