Again this year Paula and I will be hosting a Rally at our home near Ingersoll Ontario June 19 to 21st. We can accommodate 6 to a maximum of 8 coaches on our property. Our home is located on 2.5 acres surrounded by woods.



We have several 30 Amp RV outlets in our shop, however the shop is limited to 60 Amps Maximum so AC use is restricted, otherwise, it will be dry camping, Those needing reliable power for CPAP etc will be accommodated (bring a 50ft extension cord) For those wishing to stay until Monday, free dumping facilities are available about 4Km away in Ingersoll.



Because of the tight parking, this will be a staycation with all activities at our home. Those with cars and/or coming for Saturday only will be parked at our Neighbours house (same driveway entrance, just stay to right).

This will be a low stress casual friendship get-together. We have a large roofed Pavilion with a fire pit to relax around, plus a deck and other seating areas.

We have a hot tub, so bring your bathing suit if you wish.

On Saturday, Paula will be showing the Ladies her furniture painting and refinishing techniques. Paula says to bring the painting coveralls that Jim Owens donated last year, or some old clothes that you can paint in.



The guys will be have a Super Tech Session. We'll talk about wiring do's and dont's plus the usual bull session. We will have a Q&A so send me an email with you questions so I can read up and be accurate with the solutions.

We will send out an email once we know our costs which we will divide amongst the attendees. I expect them to be about \$100 Cdn per couple (same as last year).

How to find us

194641 19th line Ingersoll Ontario. If you enter our address into Google Maps, it will show you our exact location and street view shows our driveway.

- We are in a one Km stretch of road where the speed limit is reduced to 70Km/Hr. We are on the south side and share our driveway entrance with our neighbour so we have two 911 address signs at our driveway. Stay to the left driveway when you enter with a coach. If you are driving a car, stay to the right to park at our neighbour's house.

-19th line was formerly part of Highway 19 and is also called Road 119 and is called Bell Street in Ingersoll. It is the main road between Ingersoll and Thamesford.

-Some GPS units do not have proper 911 numbering for our road and will take you to a flooring store at the west side of Ingersoll. At that point you are on 19th line. Continue going west from there about 3 Kms and watch for the 911 signs on the south side (left) of the road.

From the 401, take exit 216 (Culloden Road) at Ingersoll. If coming from the East, go straight through at the lights. If coming from the West, take Culloden Road north, cross over 401 and turn left at the lights. In both cases this puts you on Ingersoll Street and takes you past the GM Cami Assembly Plant. Follow Ingersoll Street, straight through at a 4-way stop and it will dead-end at Bell Street which is also 19th line. Turn left on Bell Street and follow it for about 4Kms. You will come to a speed indicator where the Maximum Speed drops to 70Km/hr and a collection of houses along the road. Our driveway is on the South (left) side with two 911 address signs. It is the only driveway that disappears into the woods and you cannot see the house from the road.
