TWEED ELVIS FESTIVAL

LOCATION: HWY 37, North of 401 or South of Hwy 7, Tweed, Ontario. The Festival is on the east side of town at the Fairgrounds and well signed once you're in town.

All our reserved sites have been booked. Anyone else who would like to attend can contact the Festival organizers at 613-478-1691.

*Dry camping. No generators allowed during show times. **Also, no pets allowed on Fairgrounds.** We have reserved prime location sites roughly 100 feet from the stage. You can see and hear the show from your coach. Set up your lawn chairs in the stage area for the whole weekend.*

Thursday - Meet & Greet in our tent followed by Pot Luck Dinner 6:00 pm.

Friday -the show starts at 4:00 pm, until about 10:00 pm.

Saturday - Classic Car Parade in the morning - show from 10:00 am until about 10:00 pm.

Sunday - at 11:00 am, the greatest Elvis Gospel show on earth.

On Sunday is Elvis contestants' final show. At 5:00 pm the awards ceremonies is followed by the closing ceremonies. Departure or stay until Monday morning.

There are food vendors on the grounds. A hot breakfast is available 8:00 am to 1:00 pm Saturday & Sunday for \$5 per person. Pay at the location. Coffee at our tent Friday, Saturday, & Sunday morning. A small donation will be required.



Tweed Legion will have a BBQ on Saturday at 11:00 am – 5:00 pm. There is a shuttle bus service available, from the Fairground, into town, which is within walking distance.

Cost is \$190.00 per coach, two tickets to the shows (at \$70 per person), and \$50 for up to four nights dry camping.

Come early; On Thursday, 23 August gates open at noon. Be at your campsite no later than 3:00 pm Friday, 24 August.

Campsite has to be vacated by noon on Monday, 27 August.
