DRIVING DIRECTIONS

DIRECTIONS TO QUINTE'S ISLE CAMPARK

237 Salmon Point Road, Cherry Valley, ON, Canada K0K1P0,

From Toronto

Take Hwy. 401 East to exit 522, go right on Wooler Rd. to Hwy 33, go right on 33 to County Road #1, turn left on #1 straight through the roundabout at Loyalist to Lake Street, go right on 10 follow through Cherry Valley straight on County Road 18 go approximately 7km, then left on Salmon Point Rd. follow to Quinte's Isle Campark entrance on the left.

From Ottawa or Montreal

Take Hwy. 49 South (exit 566) through Picton, turn left on Lake Street to Cherry Valley straight through to County Road 18 approximately 7km to Salmon Point Road turn left follow to Park entrance on the left.
