Directions:

<u>Westbound Hwy.7</u> from Acton / Georgetown: Go through Rockwood to western town limit. Entrance to campground will be on your left.

Eastbound Hwy.7 from Guelph: Entrance on right just as you enter Rockwood.

<u>Note:</u> The campground <u>will not hold sites</u> so if you plan on coming it is best to book soon. You will need to book directly with the campground. The number to call is 1-877-558-4722. We will be in the <u>Pineview Camping Area</u>, so specify that when you call. First choice should be sites 18 to 33 and 1 to 6. If those are full, ask for sites 7 to 10 and 34-37. You can also book on-line. A campsite map is included with this registration. Sites have water and electricity, with washroom/shower facilities and dump station nearby.

(The Tiger Boys Open House is a two day affair, so if you want to spend time there on Sunday you may want to book your site for Sunday night also. We will be there Thursday through Sunday nights) Cost is \$52.00/night plus a one-time \$13.00 "reservation fee".

If you can, please bring a tow vehicle.

Friday: For those arriving on Thursday, Friday Breakfast will be held at the Airpark Cafe, pay for your own. Check in time is 2:00pm. Weather permitting, we may go the the Guelph Gremlins Flying Field for some RC flying. Maybe try your hand yourself. For the ladies, there are numerous shopping possibilities in the area.

Friday night potluck dinner. Campfire later.

<u>Saturday</u>: Continental breakfast provided, then travel to the Guelph Airpark for the "Tiger Boys" open house. There is no cost to attend. The Tiger Boys are a local group of mostly volunteers who collect and restore vintage aircraft, many of them in flying condition. They depend on donations for funding. Many of their aircraft, plus others that fly in, along with vintage cars will be on display and flying. For a cost, you can even go for a ride in an open cockpit airplane (I don't know what that cost might be at this point) They have suggested that we bring a coach along for display. They will have food available on-site, and the Airpark Cafe is also located there.

For those who may not be interested in this, along with shopping, there are other attractions in the area, listed below.

Saturday night we will have an on-site catered meal of Pulled Pork, Hamburgers, Jumbo Hot Dogs with salad and dessert provided by the Rockwood Lions Club. Campfire later.

Sunday: Continental Breakfast provided, checkout for those leaving. Tiger Boys open house continues today for those who want to go back.
